Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

This website does not require cookies in order to function properly. The information below explains the cookies we use and why.

Cookie	Used For
Cookie Bar (cb-enabled)	This is used to remember whether you have clicked the button to acknowledge our use of cookies. Without this, the bar would always show.
Social Media Sharing Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, Google, AddThis	<p>We include Facebook and Twitter plugins on this website to help you share content that may be of interest to your social network. We also use AddThis, which is a service allowing social media sharing with a range of alternatives to Facebook and Twitter.
